In July 2015, 38% of Resident Days were private pay, 51% were Medicaid and 11% were Medicare/HMO. Total daily census for the month was -4.4% from projected. It has been a slow climb, but we are seeing the growing census returning to the budgeted amount following the winter flu outbreak, and the bed holds implemented in preparation for the RCF transfers.

RJHC received a total of 22 inquiries in July, 9 of which admitted to the facility (41%).

RJHC continues to prepare for Census Development and anticipates significant growth in our skilled census over the coming year. Throughout the previous year (August 2014 – July 2015), through training and process improvement we have increased our overall Medicare Admissions, total Medicare A census days and average length of stay over the prior year. These changes amount to a financial impact for the facility of at least \$700,000 in increased revenue. We anticipate further growth in the year to come.
